On Arrival

Upon arrival to the venue, please see security on the door and they will show you to the Box Office. Give your name to the venue staff on the Box Office who will then give you a wristband that will allow you entry into the access area and a personal assistant ticket if requested. They will then explain where the lift/stairs are to get into the access area and where the toilets are. If you requested additional members of your party to be in the access area, please check with the venue staff if this is possible.

Facilities

There are large, disabled toilets on every floor equipped with emergency alarms. There is a lift which takes you directly to the entrance of the venue's access area. At the entrance of the building, there is a ramp meaning that the venue has 'step-free' access.

Blue Badge Parking

We do not have our own carpark due to being located on Oxford Road which is bus and taxi's only. However, there is an accessible carpark on Dilworth Street.
